BENCH RACING by A.J. BASTIEN

Well, I had a lot of fun last month with the "bench racing" column, so here it is again, this month, however, we went out and dug out this Pontiac Motor Division service bulletin on '64 LeMans/GTO, its kind of interesting, and the information may come in handy if yours is a '64 Goat:

Subject: Refinish 1964 Tempest LeMans Tail light bezel assembly

We have received reports of a paint peeling condition being experienced on the tail light bezel assemblies of a number of 1964 Tempest LeMans automobiles.

The following procedure, designed for field refinish, must be carefully followed if complete and lasting paint adherence is desired.

- 1) R & R tail light assembly
- 2) Disassemble tail light assembly, removing lens and weatherstripping
- 3) Clean panels and mask black painted areas
- 4) Remove paint with a commercial stripping agent such as DUPONT 999 PAINT & VARNISH REMOVER, using No. 1 steel wool
- 5) Rinse with water and dry thoroughly
- 6) Condition the metal with DUPONT VM 5717 METAL CONDITIONER or a similar product. Dry thoroughly

CAUTION: This metal conditioner is an acidic concentrate and care must be exercised to avoid skin contact

- 7) Mask panel area not to be painted
- 8) Spray with DUPONT 577 WASH PRIMER (818-012). This primer must be mixed in a 5:1 ratio (5 parts thinner to 1 part primer) and should be used or thrown away within six hours after mixing to avoid spray equipment contamination
- 9) Wipe chrome ribs clean with rag dampened with thinner using care to avoid contacting the recessed area
- 10) Spray with standard primer and wipe off chrome ribs
- 11) Paint panel with Marimba Red (Code L) and wipe off chrome ribs CAUTION: Avoid any paint contact with black area
- 12) Force dry at 180 F for 15 minutes
- 13) Reassemble tail light assembly installing lens and weatherstripping The flat rate and material allowance recommended for refinishing the assembly is:

1 panel 1.3 hours 2 panels 1.8 hours material 1/2 gt.

Effective with the receipt of this bulletin, it is no longer necessary to replace the panels. Simply refinish, following the steps outlined above. (This was issued on September 15, 1964, as an addition to dealer service manuals. I hope it helps you in restoring that '64)




