





In talking with him, I learned he ran a place called "Goat Farm GTOs" and that at the time he had approximately 10 GTOs. - Q) Exactly what did the basic GTO option consist of on the '64 model and was it available on the 2227 body (w/post doors)? I've seen hardtop coupes and coupe convertibles with the option. I've found the option price but not very many other details. Most of the GTO options are obvious, but I would like to see the list of them. (Question from, Michael Kavalukas, 118 Fifth Avenue, Carnegie, PA 15106)
- A) In 1964 Pontiac produced 32,450 GTOS.
- 7384 Sprots Coupes (2227 with piller post).
- 18,422 Hardtop Coupe (2127).
- 6644 Convertibles (2267).

Of the 32,450 GTOS produced, 8245 had the optional Tri-Power.

Prices for the Lemans were:

- Sports Coupe, \$2,491.00.
- Hardtop Coupe, \$2,556.00.
- Convertible, \$2,796.00.

The GTO option, Code #382 cost \$295.90. This included the following:

1) 389 GTO engine with 421 heads and 4 bbl. 2) 3-speed manual Hurst floor shift. 3) Stiffer shocks. 4) Heavy-duty springs. 5) Larger front sway bar. 6) Dual exhausts. 7) Low restriction mufflers and lightweight resonators. 8) Clutch fam. 9) Chromed low restriction air cleaner assy. 10) Chromed valve covers. 11) Chromed oil filter cap. 12) 14 X 6 wheel rims. 13) Choice of 7.50 X 14 premium red line or whitewalls. 14) Heavy duty rad core. 15) Heavy duty starter motor and battery. 16) GTO Id.; a) Initials on rad grille, rear quarters and deck lid. b) GTO triangular crest on front fenders and instrument panel. 17) Stylized air-intake castings on each side of hood. 18) Engine turned (swirl) aluminum dash panel applique. 19) Bucket seats. 20) Full carpeting.

Other options available as well as accesories were: -Power steering - power brakes - power bucket seat - power windows - a/c - tinted glass all around or winshield only - rear window defogger, except convert. - washers, two speed wipers - tilt steering column - padded dash - console - am/fm - power antenna - rear speaker reverb except convert. - trunk light - ski rack luggage carrier - deluxe, custom or wire sheel discs - black or white fabric top - 4 speed Hurst - 2 speed automatic - matallic brake linings - heavy duty rad - limited slip diff. - custom sport (wood) steering wheel - handling kit: extra stiff shocks and 20:1 quick steering - extra stiff shocks only - tach or clock - vacuum gauge - chrome exhaust splitters - tri-power - breakerless ign. - axle ratios available: 3.08, 3.23, 3.36, 3.55, 3.90 (some ratios required additional options such as HD rad or Matallic linings, etc.).

Golden West GTO's of Calgary, Alberta CANADA held their first meeting August 29, 1982. Paul Deane, president of the club has this report: We had 9 GTO's and 10 members show up for the first meeting. We now have 16 members. Most of the Goats were going through the restoration period. Two of these were restored. Mike Hopfner's '69 hardtop and Paul Deane's '70 Judge. We have 1-'64 hardtop, 2-'65 hardtops, 1-'66 convertible, 2-'67(1 convertible and 1 sport coupe), 7-'69 (2 Judges, 2 convertibles, 3 hardtops), 3-'70 (2 Judges, 1 hardtop), 1-'73. Three of these GTOs have hood tachs. Our first meeting, which was held in a park, lasted 3 hours. We spent most of the time electing officials and making policies and deciding what we wanted out of the club.

Curling OKeefe Brewerier has donated a meeting room and free beer 4 times a year. We are still looking for a place to hold our other monthly meetings. At the end of the meeting, we all cruised down McCleod Trail. Seeing all the goats lined up made me very pleased and happy that I did form the club. The best thing that happened though is that a genuine "Goat Girl" has joined the club. Debra owns a '69 convertible. I expect more members in the future.

One of the newest chapters to the GTOAA is the Royal GTOs, located in the Washington D.C./Baltimore area. The Royals, who have taken their name from Royal Pontiac, THE Pontiac performance dealer of the '60s, were organized in June of 1982. Many of the memebers were together in another Pontiac club prior to forming the Royals, so they are already pretty well organized, with a fourteen page bi-monthly newsletter edited by Sue Bridgett. Sue and her husband Dennis are the proud owners of two GTOs-a '69 hardtop and a '70 Ram Air IV hardtop.

The Royals are growing rapidly. As of this writing, (August 7) membership stands at 32 members and expanding every day. One of the reasons for their rapid growth in such a short period of time is their fine organization and a plethora of knowledgable people. Elected for the '82-'83 term is Jim Oakley (1966 GTO) as president, Dennis Bridgett ('69 & '70 GTO) vice-president, Jean Zazarine ('66 GTO) as secretary, and Barry Smith ('64 GTO and '69 Judge) as treasurer.

The Royals also have a Board of Directors overseeing chapter activities and business. They are Jerry Drechsler ('66 GTO), Elaine Oakley ('66 GTO), George Richardson ('64 GTO), Joe Pascale ('66 GTO) and Terry Wortman ('69 Judge). Meetings are held bi-monthly at a local Pontiac dcaler, and Activities Director Paul Zazarine ('66 GTO) tries to have some type of movie or slide show presentation for the membership's entertainment.

The Royals have a busy schedule lined up for the coming months. In August they had their yearly Day at the Farm, hosted by Dennis and Sue Bridgett. Along with food and drinks, the Royals had a Road Rallye, games, and a fun relaxing day shooting the breeze about GTOs. They participate in a large number of local car shows, promoting the GTO in the D.C. Baltimore area, and have their annual Christmas Party the week before Christmas.

This January they plan on having a Club Display in the D.C. World of Wheels, exhibiting at least a half dozen cars.



Through Chuck, Royal members can purchase Pontiac parts at a substantial discount. Paul Zazarine who has been restoring a GTO since 1977, researches and writes magazine articles about the GTO. Brian Tressler, another parts man for a Pontiac dealer is currently putting the final touches on a '68 GTO, and can offer parts to members at discount.

So that is the Royal story, a highly organized, growing chapter of the GTOAA, filled with enthusiastic people who know and love the Pontiac GTO. A. VENTSHADES
Help protect occupants from sun and rain when windows are slightly open. The ventshades fit snugly over
the top of side windows. Not available for Convertibles
or Hardtops. (D)

B. CUSTOM AIR CONDITIONER (Code 582)

It's combined with Circ-LAire heater to give full range comfort control. It heats and cools air, controls humid-ity, limits window fogging and filters the air. Lets you ride in cool or warm, clean, noise-free comfort. (F.D)

C. SOFT-RAY GLASS (Code 531)

C. SUFFIRM LASS (CORE 531) Reduce glare and enjoy more comfortable driving with fully tinted windows. The upper area of the windshield is shaded for added glare reduction. Recommended with air conditioning. Also available on windshield only. (Code 532). (F)

D. REAR WINDOW DEFOGGER (Code 374)

A blower under the rear package shelf channels air through a grille to the rear window. Result—helps give you a clear view all the time. Not available on Station Wagons or Convertibles. (F,D)

E. ROOF OR DECK LID SKI AND LUGGAGE CARRIER

E DEMOVABLE LUCCACE CARRIER - KARPAK

Lightweight, easily removed, quickly installed on root or deck lid. All models except Station Wagons with luggage carrier. (D)

G. VENTILATED CUSHION
Make summer driving more comfortable. Special coil
spring construction allows air to circulate between
passenger and seat. (D)

A. REMOTE-CONTROL OUTSIDE MIRROR

Mounts on left-hand door. Convenient and easy to adjust from inside car. (F,D)

B. FRONT SEAT SHOULDER STRAPS (Code 434)

Give extra security by keeping the torso erect in case of sudden stors. Available with all seat betts for driver and front seat passenger. One end is anchored to the floor, the other end is anchored at the root rail above the driver or passenger on all models except Convert the driver or passenger on all models except Convert The shoulder strap is worn diagonally across the storior in conjunction with your seat bett. It has a pushbutton buckle release, (F,D)

C. SEAT BELT RETRACTORS FOR STANDARD REAR SEAT BELTS

D. CUSTOM FRONT AND REAR SEAT BELTS WITH RETRACTORS (Code 701)
On 4-door models Custom Seat Belts with retractors in both front and rear seats. F. CUSTOM SPORTS STEERING WHEEL (Code 471) Handsome "just like wood" appearance. Has three equally spaced, brushed stainless steel spokes. Horn button in center. (F)

G. HOOD RETAINERS

H. RALLY STRIPE PACKAGE

Get the Sports Car appearance. Rally stripe goes from the front of the hood, over the top to the rear edge of the deck. Available in Red, Black, White and Blue. (D)

I. DUAL STAGE, HEAVY-DUTY AIR CLEANER

(Code 361)
Dual filter design consists of wetted paper inner filter
surrounded by a special polyglycol wetted polyurethane foam outer filter. These two filters give finer
filtration, extended service. Not available on the 4
barrel OHC 6 cylinder engine or GTO with 4 barrel
engine. (F,O)

I. TACHOMETER

A. SAFE-T-TRACK DIFFERENTIAL (Code 731)

Tempest Custom, Tempest Safari, Le Mans and GTO.
(F.D)

D. RALLY CLOCK (Code 474)
Features sweep second hand and special built-in
automatic self regulator. Illuminated dial for easy
night reading. Not available with Rally Cluster Option
(code 444) (F.D.)

E. RALLY GAUGE. CLUSTER, AND TACHOMETER (Code 444) Includes 250° sweep tachometer, speedometer, oil pressure and water temperature gauges—plus fuel indicator and battery tell-tale light. (F).

F. TRANSISTORIZED VOLTAGE REGULATOR

G. SUPERLIFT SHOCK ABSORBERS, REAR

H. CAPACITOR DISCHARGE IGNITION SYSTEM

(Lode 6/1)
The finest of ignition systems, Gives ignition without condenser or mechanical contacts. Combines increased high-speed output with greater ignition stability. Lengthens spark plug life, is rugged and waterproof. Available as option for premium fuel engines only. Not available on cars with AMF-FM racio. (F)

DUAL EXHAUSTS (Code 481)
Cuts down back pressure in exhaust system, adds to engine efficiency. Available on 326 V-8 regular fuel engine only. Standard on GTO models and 326 HO V-8 engines. (F)

A. LUGGAGE LAMP (Code 401) Lights automatically when trunk lid is lifted. Permits free use of both hands for loading and unloading lug-gage at night. Not available on Station Wagons. (F.D)

B. SIDE ROOF RAIL AND READING LAMPS (Code 404)

(Code 404)
Mounted on interior side of roof rails. One lamp on each side. They light up when the door is opened, each lamp has an individual switch. Not available on Convertibles. (F)

C. GLOVE COMPARTMENT LAMP (Code 402)

D. ASHTRAY AND LIGHTER LAMPS (Code 412) They glow automatically when parking lamps or head lamps go on. Plainly seen when ashtray is pulled out or when lighter is removed. (F,D)

E. UNDERHOOD LAMP (Code 421) Unit similar to Luggage Lamp, but located under engine hood. Available on all models (F,D) (not illustrated)

F. ANTI-THEFT BARRIER
A heavy-gauge, sheel wire mesh screen fits between the rear seat and the trunk compartment. Gives extra protection; it's botted from the trunk side; cannot be dismantled from the passenger side. Available on Convertibles only. Note: Spare tire wheel cover is available only through your dealer while supply lasts.

G. RED FENDER LINERS (Code 522)

Red heavy-duty plastic liners for the front fender skirts and rear wheelhouse areas give every Tempest added dash and flair. Not available on Station Wagons. (F,D)

H. VACUUM GAUGE Available with console only. Vacuum gauge measures manifold vacuum—lets you know when you're driving in the most economical fuel range. (D)

I. IGNITION AND STARTER SWITCH LAMP (Code 422)

(Coe 422)

Turn on your parking lights and a special light makes
the ignition switch immediately visible. No more
fumbling to find the keyhole. (F)

J. SAFEGUARD SPEEDOMETER (Code 442) Warns of excess speed. Control knob lets you select desired speed limit. Buzzer signals when car exceeds this speed. Not available with Rally Cluster. (F)

K. INSTRUMENT PANEL COURTESY LAMP (Code 411)

(Code 411)

Lights when front door is opened. Also manually oper ated with panel switch located under the instrument panel. Standard on Convertibles. (F.D)

L. HIGHWAY EMERGENCY KIT

Includes antenna emergency flag, fire extinguisher tire inflator and warning flares and extra fuses. (D)

A. POWER STEERING (Code 501)
One or two pounds of effort is all you need for the easiest steering you'll ever experience. Makes driving, turning and parking a breeze. (F,D)

B. POWER BRAKES (Code 502)

Just a light touch of the toe gives adequate braking pressure. Includes bright metal trim plate on brake pedal when factory-installed. (F,D)

C. REAR DECK LID RELEASE (Code 492)

Here's real convenience. You can release the trunk lock electrically from the driver's seat. The pushbutton control is located inside the glove box. The trunk also may be unlocked with a key. All models except Station Wagons. (F,D)

D. CRUISE CONTROL (Cade 441)
Maintain a preselected speed automatically by
depressing a button located at the end of your turn
signal indicator lever. Cruise control releases to accelerator control with sightsst thres

E. POWER 4-WAY BENCH SEAT (Code 566) Variable seat positions for greater comfort and less fatigue on trips. Change position seasily. With full-width seat only. (*)

F. POWER BUCKET SEAT (L.H. only) (Code 564)

G. POWER CONVERTIBLE TOP (Code 544)

H. TILT STEERING WHEEL (Code 504)
Adjusts to seven different positions for individual driving comfort. Permits easier entry and exit, better visibility for shorter people. Available with Power Steering only. Not with 3-speed column shift. (F)

I. POWER WINDOWS (Code 551)

Protect your Convertible interior from hot sun when the top is down. Made of sturdy vinyl, it snaps on and off in a jiffy. Can be left on when driver is alone in the car (f):

C. CUSTOM FOAM CUSHION—FRONT SEAT (Code 37))
For front bench seat only. Custom 2½* foam pad reduces shocks, gives a more relaxing ride. Available only on Tempest austom models. Standard with Strato-bucket seats. (F)

E. CHROME TISSUE DISPENSER
Holds a regular-size box of tissues. Swings back under
the center of the control panel when not in use. Locks
in place. Not available on cars equipped with air
conditioning. (D)

F. ENGINE BLOCK WATER HEATER Electric pre-heater for engine coolant provides fa effortless starts, quick heater action during seve cold. Single unit raises engine coolant overnight fro 0°F to 50°F, dual unit to about 90°F. Operates fro standard house electrical outlet. (D)

G. SPARE TIRE LOCK Prevents theft of spare tire and wheel in trunk. (D)

A. DELCO STEREO TAPE PLAYER (Code 354)

A. DELO STEREO TAPE PLAYER (Code 354)
Mounted under the instrument panel with or without console. The Deloc Stereo Tape Player comes with one rear speaker, puts the standard front speaker. It's that its own built-in amplifiers and plays the new Atrack Stereo Tape Cartridges. It has a "Salance" control that lets you vary the volume between the front and rear speakers. It also has a track selector and tone and volume controls. Not available with hest-eries care. (CP)

B. PUSHBUTTON AM-FM RADIO WITH MANUAL ANTENNA (Code 344)

C. PUSHBUTTON RADIO AND MANUAL ANTENNA

(Code 342)
Superior tone and fidelity. Completely transistorized.
Wide dial provides space for precise turning. (F,D)

D. MANUAL CONTROL RADIO AND MANUAL ANTENNA (Code 548) Completely transistorized. Excellent tone quality and fidelity. Wide dial for precise tuning. (F,D)

E. REAR SPEAKER (Code 351)
Brilliant tone and depth control. 3-step switch lets you play front, rear or both speakers. Not available with Delco Stereo Tape Player (F,D)

F. VERBRA-PHONIC REAR SPEAKER (Code 352)
Brilliant tone simulates acoustics in an auditorium when both speakers are playing. 3-step switch lets you play through front, rear or both speakers. All models except Station Wagons and cars with Delco Stereo Tape Player. (F,D)

G. ELECTRIC POWER ANTENNA (Code 341) Available with all radios. Raises and lowers the antenna by a switch on the instrument panel. Antenna is mounted on right rear fender on all models. Not available on Station Wagons. (F,O)

A. CUSHION TOPPER

Added front seat comfort. Sleek rayon with foam back-ing available in five colors to match interiors. (D) B. CAR COMPASS Dependable with special compensator for in-car use. Illuminated dial. (D)

C. FIRE EXTINGUISHER

A 5-lb., dry chemical fire extinguisher for all types of fires, including grease, oil, gasoline and electrical. It's rechargeable. (D)

D. DOOR EDGE GUARDS (Code 382) These bright, stainless steel strips help prevent nicks and scratches on door edges. (F,D)

E. HEAVY-DUTY BATTERY (Code 678) This 61 amp. hr. battery provides longer life, greater power and increased cranking ability. Its "thru the partition" cell connection structure adds wattage. Keeps your power accessories operating efficiently. (F.D.)

F. TRUNK AUXILIARY FLOOR MAT. (Code 362)
A heavy-duty, rugged, solid vinyl floor mat gives extra
protection for trunk compartment as well as for cargo.
Not available on Station Wagens. (F.)

G. FULL-WIDTH FLOOR MAT (Front only)

Long-lasting, easily removed for cleaning. Extends over center tunnel, protects whole floor. Available in six Pontiac colors. (D)

I. REAR DOOR LOCK GUARDS (4-Door Models Only)

J. FLOOR MATS, FRONT (Code 631) REAR (Code 632)

Keep car looking new. Easily removed for washing.






